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Description of fees

Application Fee: This amount is required to process application and includes a PAPI (Placement Admission Proficiency Interview.) and are nontransferable and nonrefundable.

Innovation Institute Fee: The amount consists of \$40 applied to cultural specials and \$70 applied to field trips

Books and Materials: These are included in your tuition.

Room/Meal plan: this amount is based on costs for a shared room (two or more students). Individual can be arranged at different cost. Students will be provided a light breakfast before classes begins, brain-friendly snacks during the day as our program is based on neuro-pedagogy. Part of the training day includes lunch and dinner. On the weekend meals will be provided at the place where they will stay. Additional food is at the student's discretion and will be paid for by the individual student.

Personal Expenses: this estimated amount is provided for each student's miscellaneous expenses. Actual expenses may differ from student to student at in the discretion of the individual student.

Total for USA visa: These figures apply for a full-time program and will be useful for your visa Certificate of Eligibility
